### INTRODUCTION

I think that modern children (and some adults) will find it useful and interesting to learn about the life of children of past years. So that it won't be like Hamlet said "The link of time has broken up" from the tragedy of William Shakespeare's "Hamlet". Knowledge of the life and lifestyle of previous generations is not only useful, but also necessary.

I am Kafarov Rza Ragimovich. In Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, I had a meeting with first-grade schoolchildren at the Dunya Mektebi school (translated as the World School). The meeting place was the School Library. This school hosts an event called "Personal Stories. Life as it was before our appearance." In total, there were 56 schoolchildren in the first three classes, as well as their teachers and educators.

**I am sure that everyone needs to remember and take into account the remarkable words of the outstanding Soviet and Russian writer Sergey Vladimirovich Mikhalokoy: "TODAY IS CHILDREN, TOMORROW IS PEOPLE". That is, how in our time they will learn, develop, bring up children will depend on what their country will be in the future.**

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**Hello dear children! Hello teachers and educators! I will tell you what the life of the schoolchildren of your years was like when I was in school, and I will also tell you how I wrote the fairy tale "Camel, Crocodile and Friday". My story will be accompanied by thematic pictures and video films.**

***I was born in Baku city, in a country that was called the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (abbreviated USSR). My father was a scientist who worked in the field of selection of farm animals. My early years were happy, I had a father and mother. Later I did not have a dad, fascist Germany attacked the USSR - the war began. Life for all has become difficult. The fascist German forces sought to seize Baku, because Baku produced oil and produced gasoline, which was fueled at the front of aircraft and tanks. People in Baku worked day and night, trying to give the Red Army as much fuel as possible. Sometimes at night fascist airplanes flew to Baku, then an air-raid was announced, searchlights were switched on to illuminate this plane in the sky. When the plane was lit in the sky, anti-aircraft guns started firing at it. Fascist aircraft received damage and fell to the ground. The Red Army did not allow the Nazis in Baku, defeated their army, and the war ended with the victory of the USSR in Berlin. This holiday is celebrated every year on May 9th.***

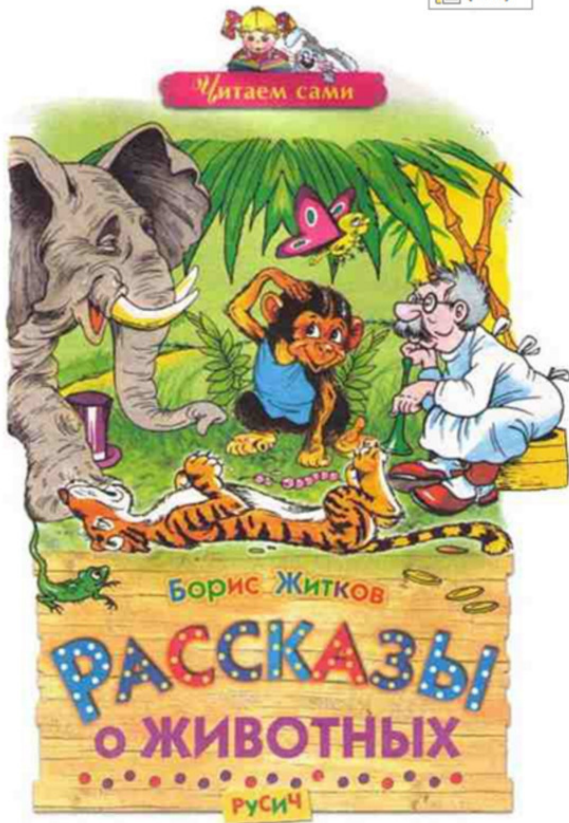

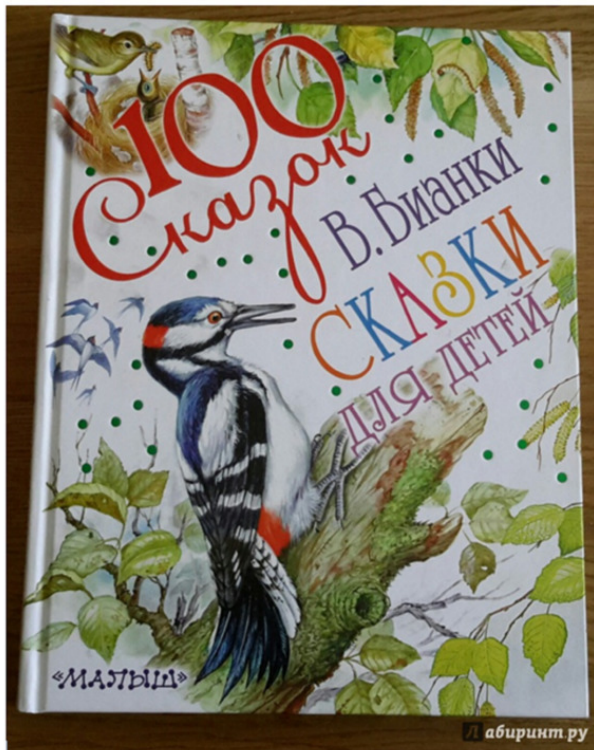

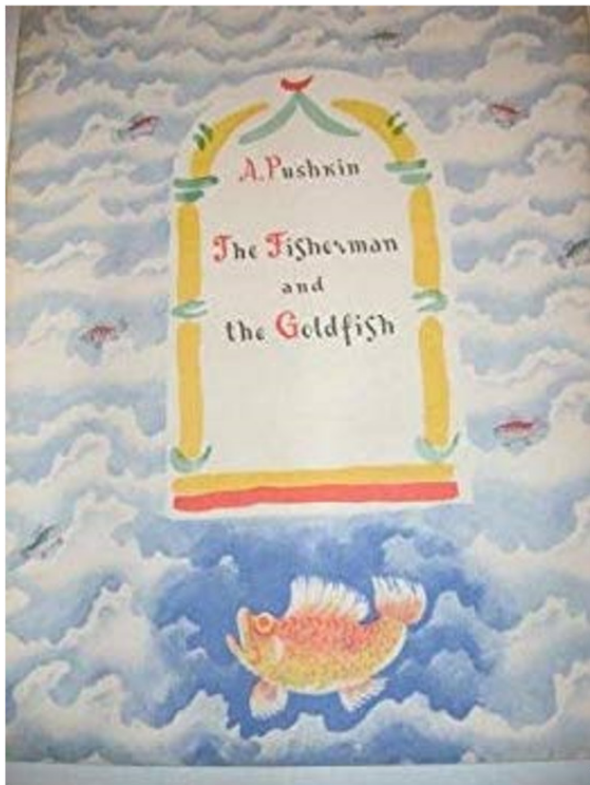

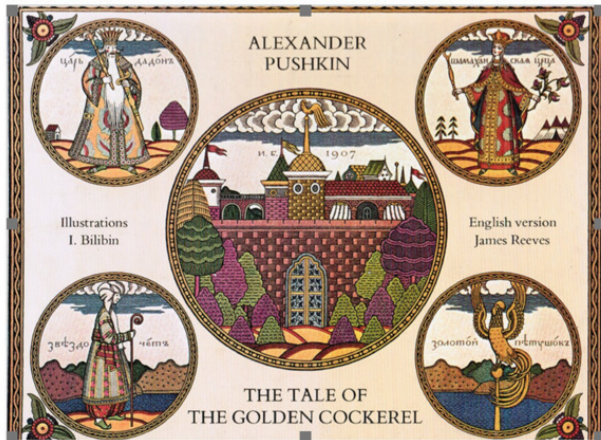
